TIME PERIODS: Times of the year and times of the day are defined as follows:

Summer (service from May 1 through October 31):

Peak: 2:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. Monday through Friday
 Partial-Peak: 7:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Monday through Friday
 AND 9:00 p.m. to midnight Monday through Friday
 Plus 5:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. Saturday and Sunday
 Off-Peak: All other hours.

Winter (service from November 1 through April 30):

Partial-Peak: 7:00 a.m. to midnight Monday through Friday
 AND 5:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. Saturday and Sunday
 Off-Peak: All other hours.

NOTE: this PG&E electric rate schedule is only for residential customers with an electric vehicle.

* Includes a baseline credit of \$0.01679 per kWh (applied to Tier 1)
